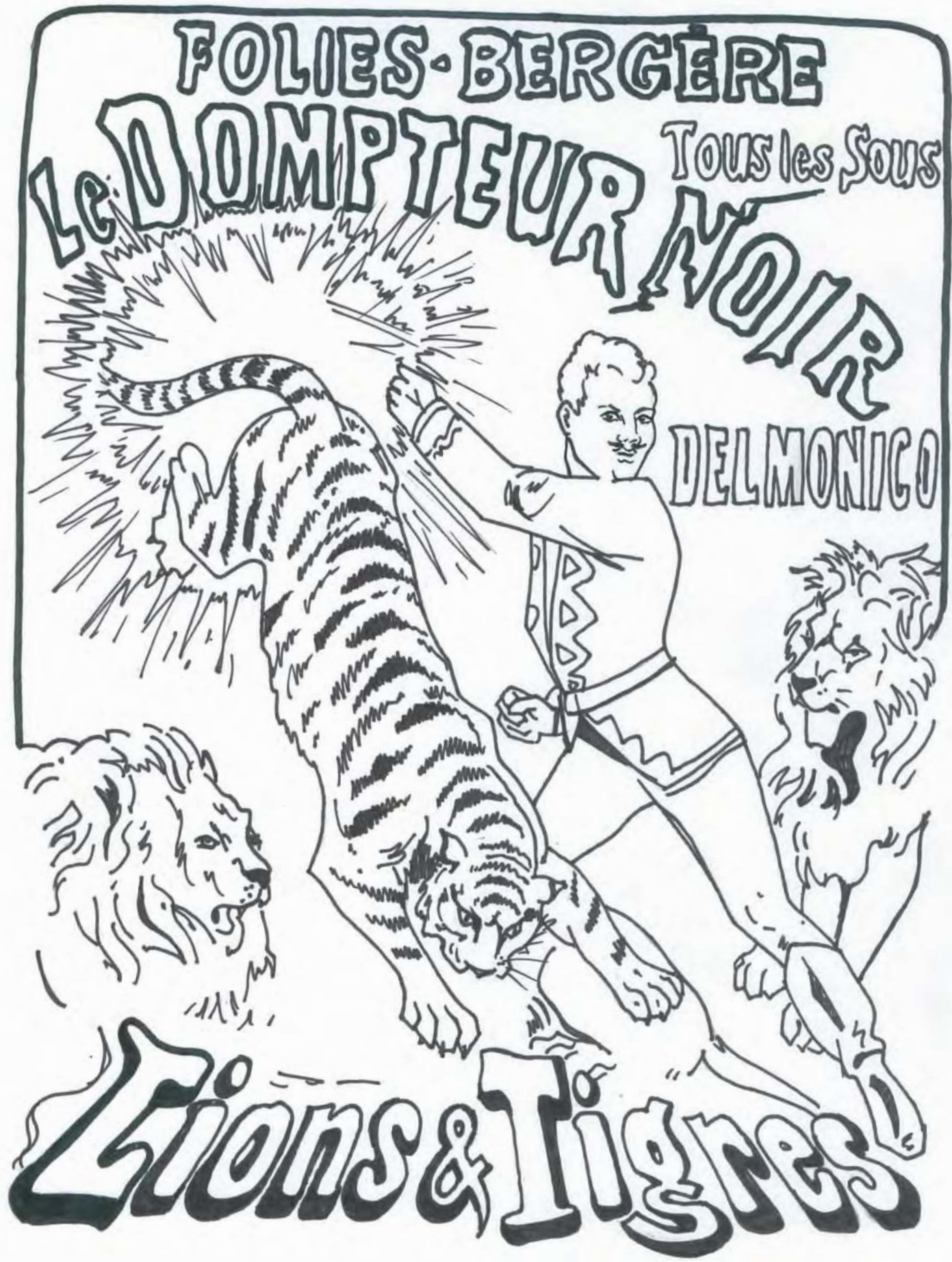

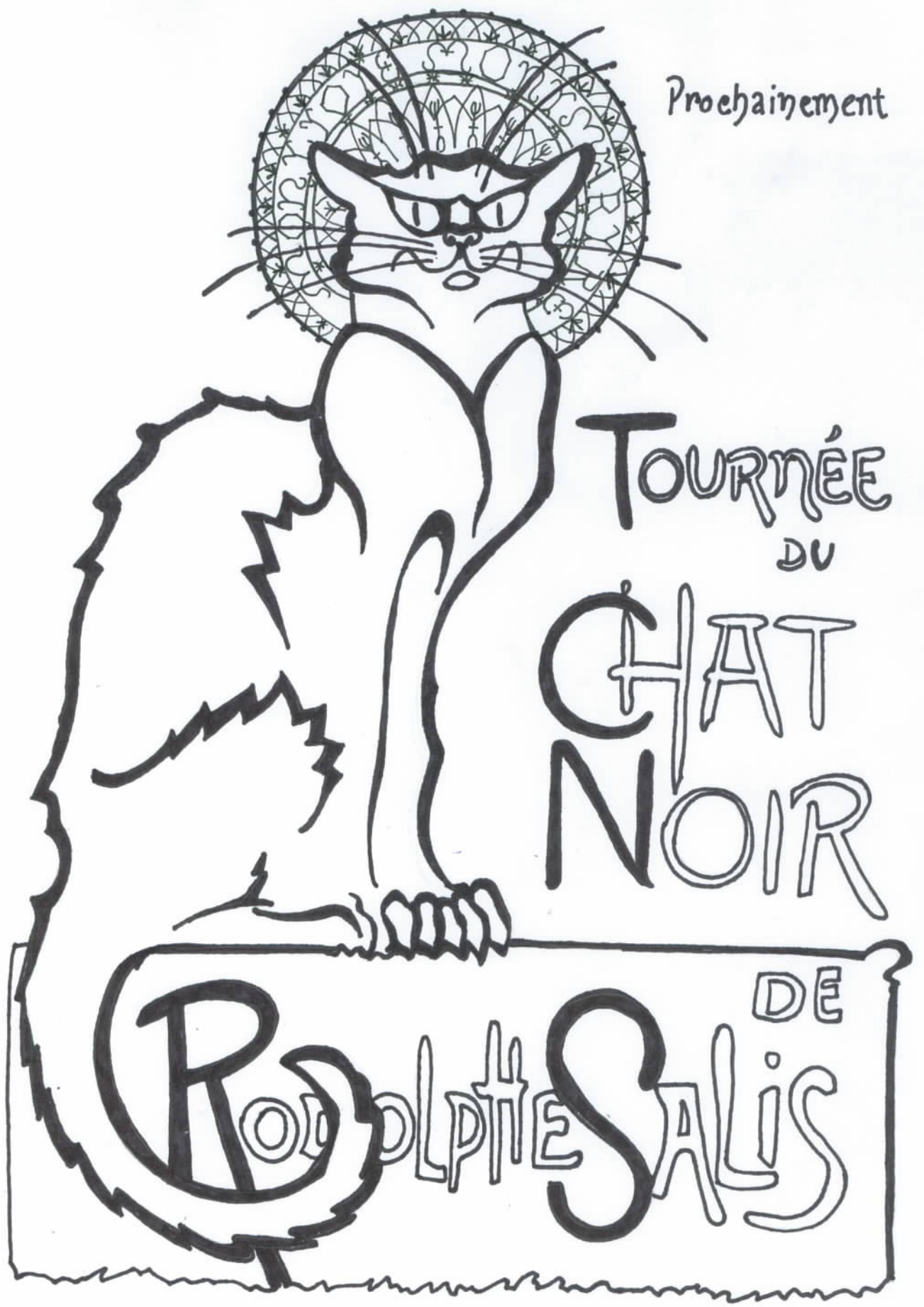

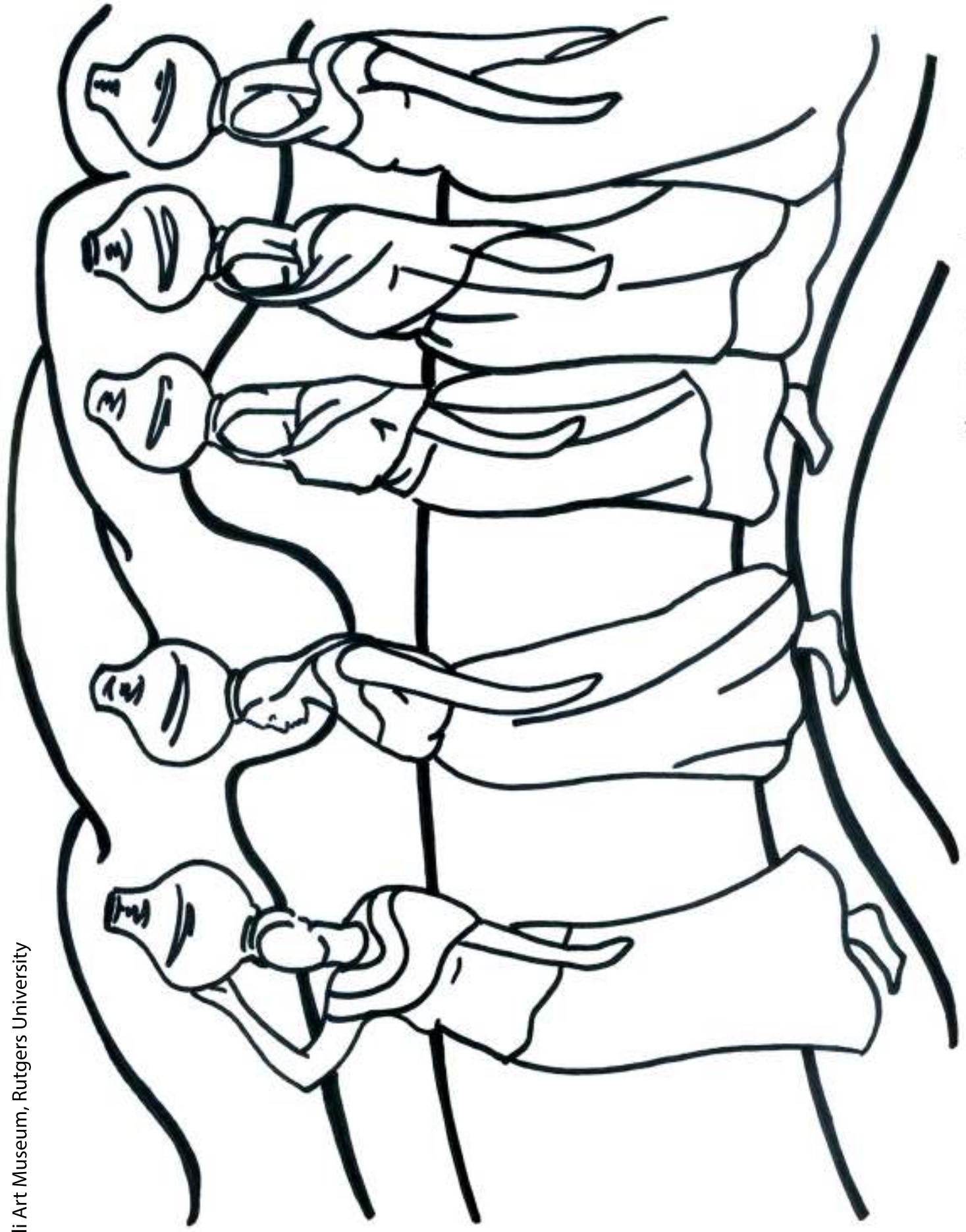

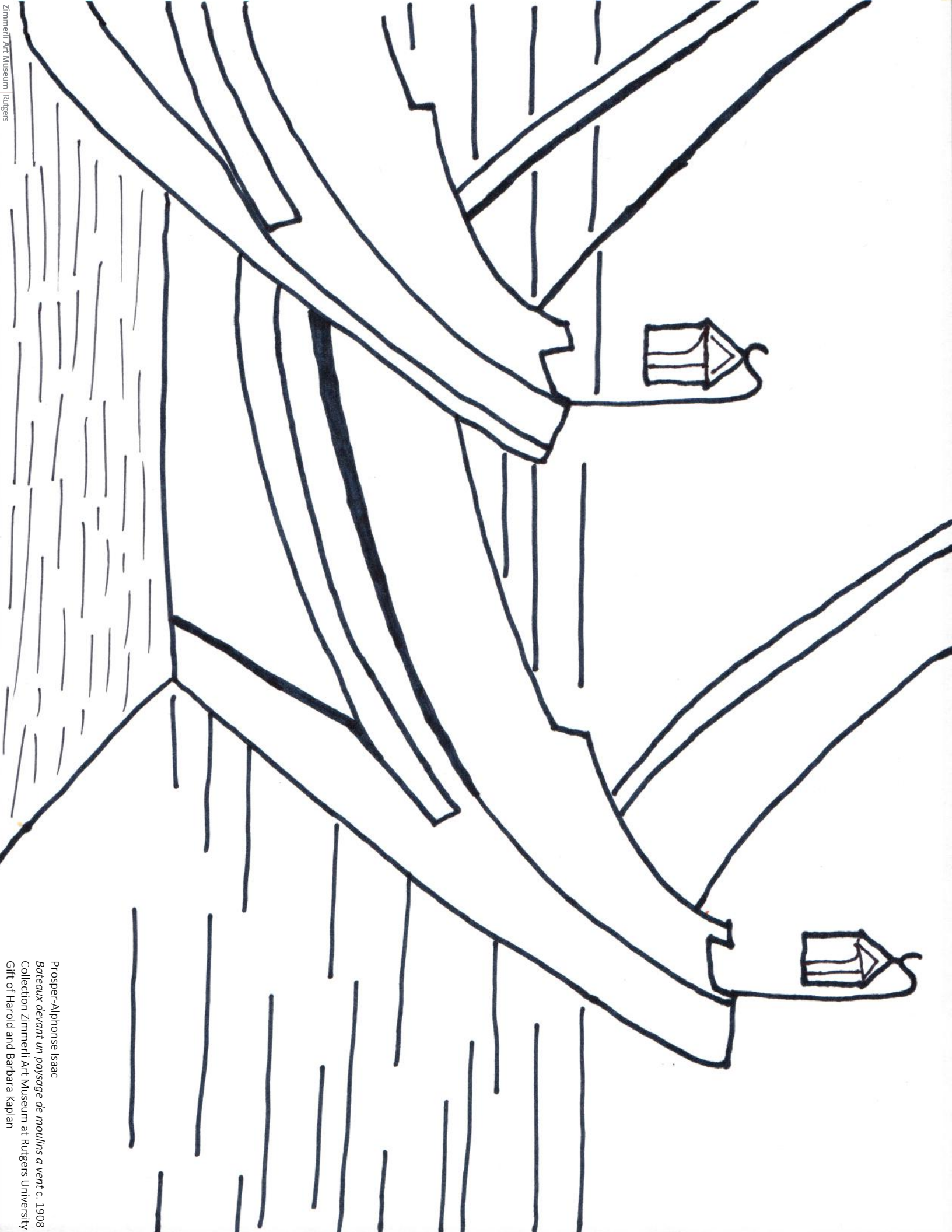

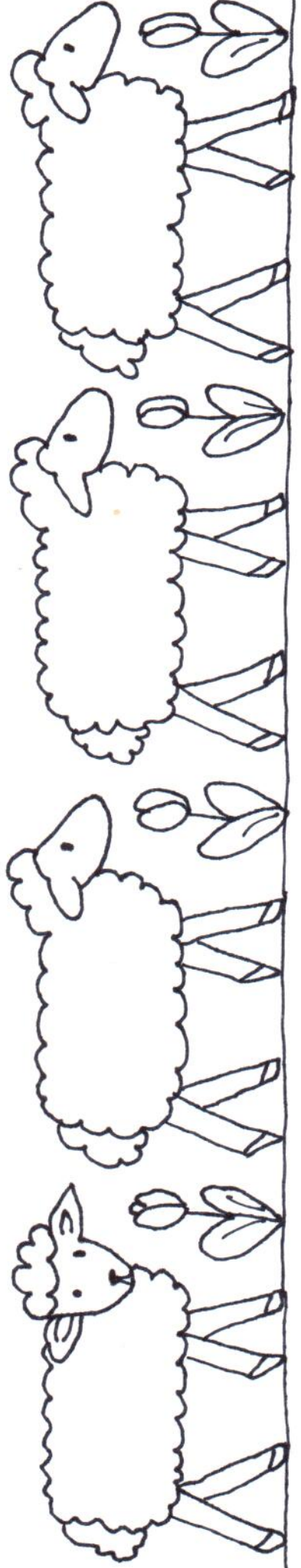
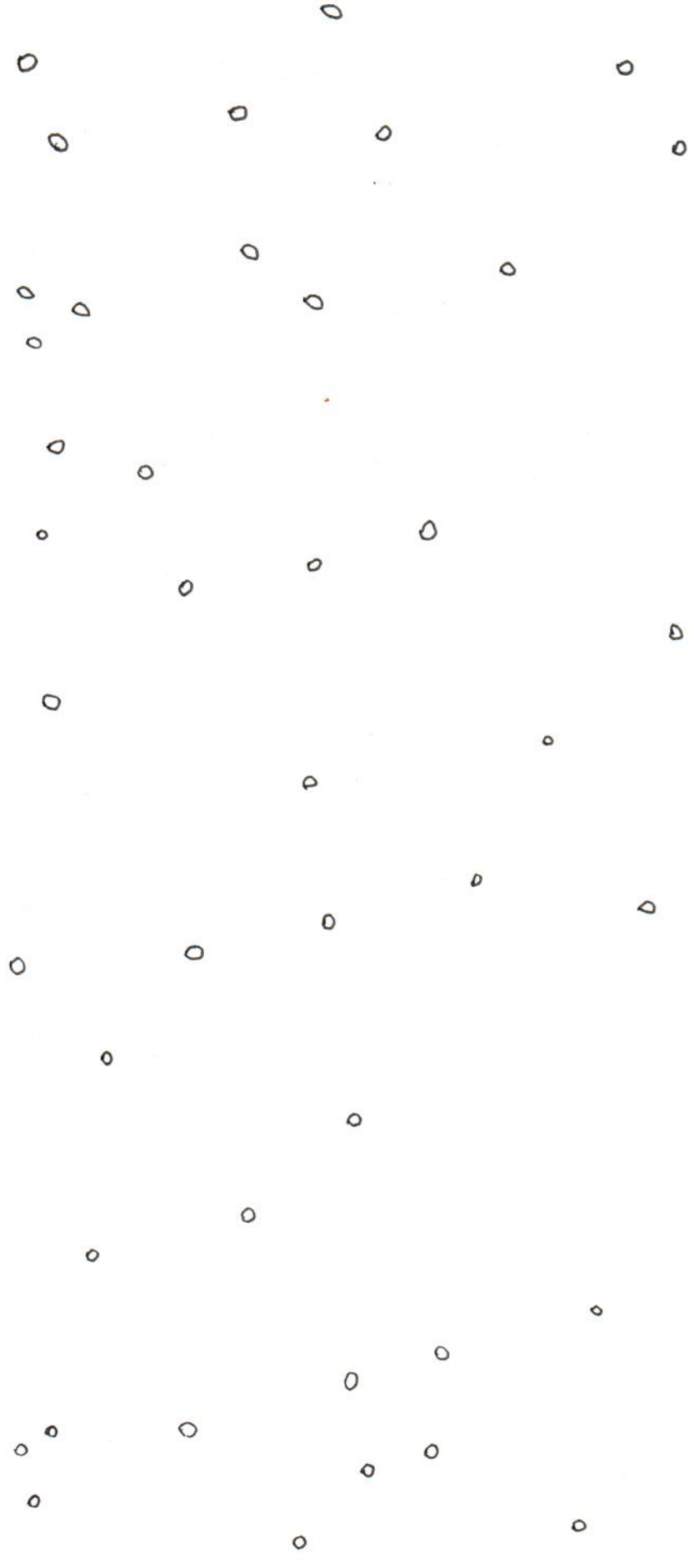
Nicholas Roerich, *The Sacred Lake*, 1917

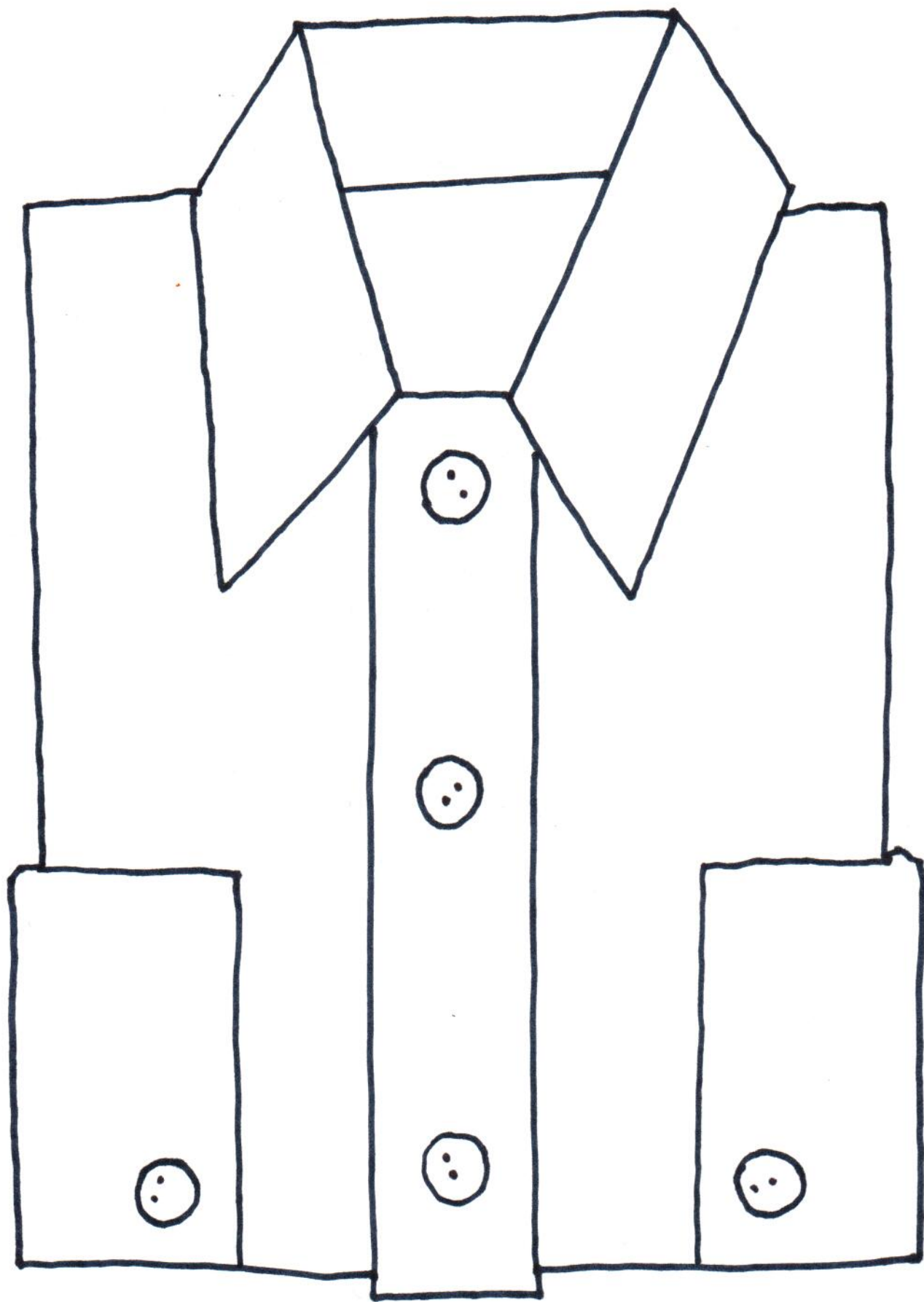
